

As a patient of Dr. Basch since October 20, 2009, I can confidently recommend his professional medical services to members in the Armed Forces.

I began seeing Dr. Basch upon my return from my fourth deployment in Iraq due to chronic neck and back pain. The problem began during my third deployment in 2006 and I have had limited success with other medical treatments until I began treatments with Dr. Basch.
